

Products and Outcomes of CHIP Process

The following is a summary of the anticipated outcomes and products of the CHIP process in Sarasota County.

Information Gathered/Reports Produced:

- County-wide *Statistical Assessment* of key health problems in Sarasota County
- *Statistical assessment* of health problems in target communities & neighborhoods
- Summary of *Focus Groups* with 3-4 groups per community about health
- Summary of *Health System Assessment* for County and each community
- Summary of *household surveys* with 900 residents concerning health issues
- Summary of major health *problems and opportunities for improvements* identified in above assessments
- *Strategic plans* (developed by the community CHATs) for health improvement
- *Monitoring plans and results* for each community
- *Evaluation report* on process and outcomes of CHIP

Improved Community Awareness and Communications:

- Increased community awareness of health needs in communities/neighborhoods
- Increased community-level discussions and local problem solving
- Improved awareness of health care services

Improved Community Empowerment and Organization:

- Established organizational framework for assessing and solving local health concerns
- Local Action teams empowered to address health problems of interest
- Improved collaborations across communities and agencies to solve health problems

Improved Community Health:

- Residents will have improved access to health care services
- Residents will improve their health status through primary prevention and treatment
- Residents will have improved health status – lower mortality and morbidity
