

# Indicator: Income Below Poverty Level

**Description:** Percentage of the population with an income over the past 12 months that was below the federal poverty level.

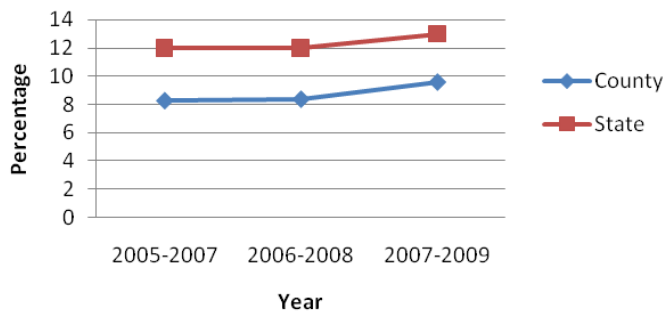
**Sources:** American FactFinder—American Community Survey (2005-2007);(2006-2008);(2007-2009) - Table C17001

**Caveats:** Data is presented as a 3 year average in order to minimize single year variability. Information is missing in the American Community Survey if the population is under 20,000 people. Missing data is represented as white space on the maps presented below.

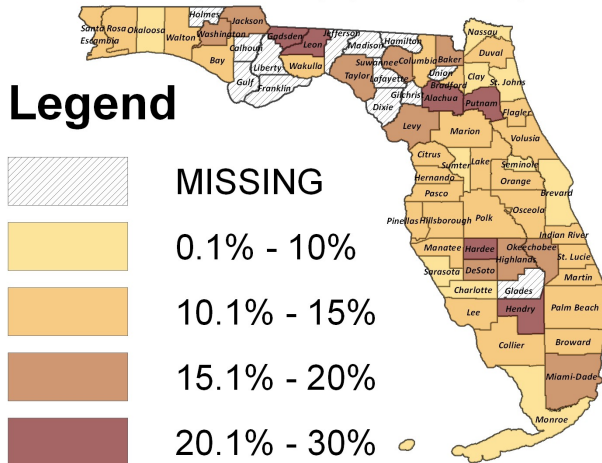

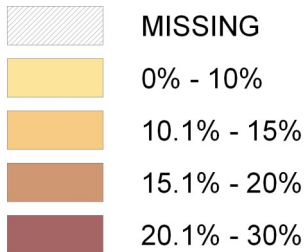

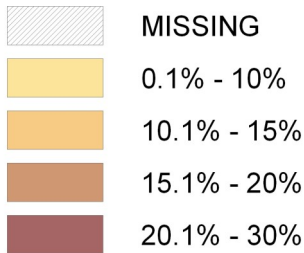
Percentage of Population in Poverty By County (2005-2007)

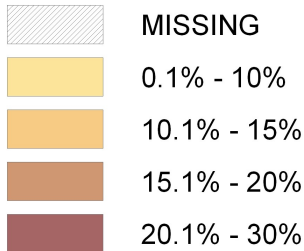
Percentage of Population in Poverty By County (2006-2008)

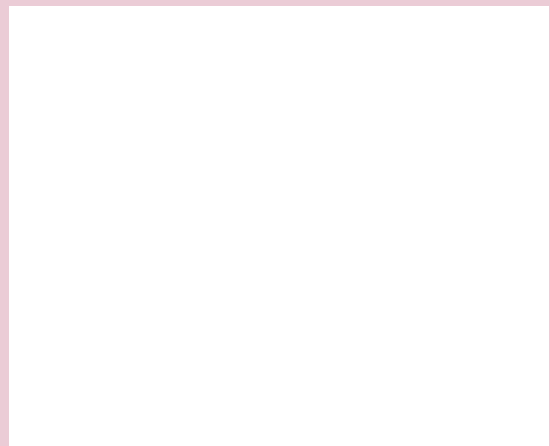


Percentage of Population in Poverty By County (2007-2009)
